1. **RAGGING** has been declared as an illegal activity inside and outside the Campus. University Orders on the subject are very clear. All students are hereby cautioned not to indulge in these unlawful activities. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against default of the Orders banning Ragging within or outside the Institutional area.
2. Students found absent from their classes would also be presumed indulging in these activities, which may attract disciplinary action.
3. Watch and Ward Staff will ensure and stop the illegal entry of the personnel in the College Premises
4. Relevant Extract from Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University **Notification No.F.18(88/92/CB/Edc./PF/ dated January 2000** on the subject matter is reproduced below for information of all students and Staff.

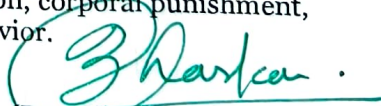
EXTRACT FROM UNIVERSITY NOTIFICATION ON RAGGING

Ragging in any form shall be strictly prohibited within the premises of the University, a college or an institution, as the case may be, or in any part of the University system as well as on public transport, or at any other place, public or private.

Any individual or collective act or practice or ragging shall constitute an act or gross indiscipline and shall be dealt with under the provisions of this ordinance.

Ragging, for the purposes of this ordinance, shall ordinarily mean any act, conduct or practice by which the dominant power or statues of senior students is brought to bear upon the students who are in any way considered junior or inferior by the former and includes individual or collective acts or practices which

- a. Involve physical assault or threat to use physical force.
- b. Violate the status, dignity and honour of students, in particular women students and those belonging to a scheduled caste or scheduled tribe;
- c. Expose students to ridicule or contempt or commit an act which may lower their self esteem; and
- d. Entail verbal abuse, mental or physical torture, aggression, corporal punishment, harassment, trauma, indecent gesture and obscene behavior.

NOTICE: ANTI RAGGING MEASURES

The Students are advised not to indulge in ragging of the freshers. Any student found indulging in such activities is likely to be punished. In this connection please note that:

1. The Supreme Court of India directive dated 4th May 2001 is very important. It states "any student found ragging shall be punished severely. The punishment includes expulsion/ suspension from the classes as well as from the Institute". Also a fine with public apology has been suggested.
2. Also, all the benefits that a student gets shall be withdrawn which include withholding of results as well.

NOTICE: ANTI RAGGING MEASURES

In pursuance of the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of INDIA, and AICTE notification no **F.NO.37-3/LEGAL/AICTE/2009 DATED 01-07-2009**, regarding prevention and prohibition of ragging in technical institutions, ragging is strictly prohibited in **Delhi Institute of Science and Technology**, Naangli Poona, New Delhi-110036. The college shall take a strict punitive action against any student found to be indulging in the ragging. To monitor the same in the college premises, following anti-ragging squad have been constituted for academic session 2025-26.:

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Functions of the Anti-Ragging Squad

- The Anti-Ragging Squad shall be responsible for maintaining vigil, oversight and patrolling functions and shall remain mobile, alert and active at all times.
- It shall be the duty of the Anti-Ragging Squad to be called upon to make surprise raids on hostels, and other places vulnerable to incidents and having the potential for ragging and shall be empowered to inspect such places.
- It shall also be the duty of the Anti-Ragging Squad to conduct an on-the-spot enquiry into any incidents of ragging referred to it by the Head of the institution or any member of the faculty or any member of the staff or any student or any parent or guardian or any employee of a service provider or by any other person, as the case may be; and the enquiry report along with recommendations shall be submitted to the Anti-Ragging Committee for action. Provided that the Anti-Ragging Squad shall conduct such enquiry observing a fair and transparent procedure and the principles of natural justice and after giving adequate opportunity to the student or students accused of ragging and other witnesses to place before it the facts, documents and views concerning the incidents of ragging, and considerations such other relevant information as may be required.
